Autumn Term Coverage

A combination of games and formal methods are used to support learning. Each week homework is provided and children are asked to return for marking. At the end of each term a formal meeting is held between parents and teacher.

Introduction to comprehensions:

Comprehension is a key part of all 7+ exams. During this term we shall be learning how to

- interpret the text
- write answers in full sentences
- use the text to support your answers
- answer both inference and retrieval questions
- be a detective in both fiction and non fiction texts

All fiction texts are written by our team to support language development as well as comprehension skills.

Language and writing skills :

High level language skills are essential for a success 7+ journey, this is assessed in both VR and writing. Not all schools assess writing in stage one exams, if not they are often incorporated into stage two. During this term we shall be

- Learning new language each week
- Learning how to develop sentences with the use of adverbs, adjectives similes and alliteration
- Write stories and descriptions
- Using capital letters, full stops, commas, explanation marks and question marks correctly.
- Change tenses with ease

Classes and teachers

There is a maximum of eight children per class with at least one teacher. The class is led by Patricia, a former headteacher and now a full time entrance exam teacher. She has supported many children to gain entry to super selective schools across the UK including St. Pauls, Westminster, Cheltenham ladies College, St. Mary's, Lambrook , Eton, King's College and Winchester. .
